

# Instructions for wear checks of play equipment

The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:

Proof of maintenance

**Date of installation** .....


Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.

Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on

- the location
- the usage
- the frequency of use
- possible vandalism

**Pattern Board**  
**Order No. 10.15000**



The board must be moved vigorously at regular intervals. Otherwise deposits from the liquid may result in permanent clouding of the pane.

## Wooden parts

1. Check for rot and, if necessary, smooth out splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks.
2. **Recommendation:** apply wood preservative wax ([www.complex-farben.com](http://www.complex-farben.com)) once a year.

## Bearing

3. Check for stability. Check that bolts and screws are tight and retighten if necessary.

## Filling

4. Move the board vigorously on a regular basis in order to dissolve any deposits that may begin to form.

## Stainless steel

5. Clean with stainless steel spray ([www.kim-tec.de](http://www.kim-tec.de)) using a clean cloth.

## Acrylic glas/macrolon

6. Clean with commercially available dishwashing liquid or, better still, plastic cleaner ([www.burnus.de](http://www.burnus.de)), under no circumstances use spirits or turpentine!

## Structural stability

7. In order to check the posts for rot, uncover the foundations once a year.

Special notes, e.g. for repairs

**Repair not carried out, equipment is taken out of action**




