


<p>Instructions for wear checks of play equipment</p>	<p>The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:</p>	<p>Proof of maintenance</p>	
<p>Playground.....</p> <p>Date of installation</p> <p>Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.</p> <p>Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - location - usage - frequency of use - possible vandalism <p>For more details see also our general instructions for maintenance of playgrounds!</p> <p>Caterpillar - Type 04 Order No. 5.00025</p> 	<p>Wooden parts</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Check for rot and, if necessary, smooth out splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks. <input type="checkbox"/> 2. Check that all bolts and screws are tight and retighten if necessary. <input type="checkbox"/> 3. If required, touch up or renew paintwork. <input type="checkbox"/> <p>Turntable</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Check that turntable move smoothly. <input type="checkbox"/> <p>Sand shovel</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Check for wear and stability. <input type="checkbox"/> <p>Antennae</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Check that antennae are securely connected. <input type="checkbox"/> 7. Replace if steel reinforcement is damaged. <input type="checkbox"/> <p>Structural stability</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8. In order to check for rot at wooden parts and steel feet for corrosion, uncover the foundations once a year. <input type="checkbox"/> 		<p>Special notes, e.g. for repairs</p>
